And that, although the old racers were good for some surprises in the preparation time. If some did not want to drive as they should, others self-confidently acknowledged the service with a small cloud of smoke. Some oldies, on the other hand, lead such a self-confident life of their own that even intensive attention is no guarantee for trouble-free racing ...

Nevertheless, the old racing cars did well and showed surprisingly good driving performances even with an operating voltage of only 9 volts.


So the overall impression is positive so far. As before, all vehicles were powered by classic open-frame engines with a block magnet.

Sleek roadsters (Race 5), motorcycles with sidecars (Race 6), small Le Mans bolides (Race 8) and a wild bunch of Minis (Race 10) made their debut at the VINTAGE GRAND PRIX DE MINIATURE.

VINTAGE GRAND PRIX DE MINIATURE Information

Event VINTAGE GRAND PRIX DE MINIATURE. Competition race meeting for historic slot cars in 1/32 scale. Date: 11/27/2021. The competition was carried out under the applicable 2G and hygiene rules. Organizer and location: Kurt Chr. Petri, 64291 Darmstadt, Germany.

Circuit MINIWOOD race track. Operating system: Analogue / International. Track: Sport (Hornby). Layout: 4-lane, lap length 11.08m. Wiring: International (DS Stop & Go Pro Boxes), with additional extensions and Ø4mm banana plugs. Power supply: Transformers (DS Power 5) 4-20V/5A. A separate transformer is used for each lane. The operating voltage used is 9V. Lap timing and counting: Racing Computer (DS 300 Pro Series).

Vehicles Historical slot cars according to VMRO. Like the original vehicles, the models also start in different racing classes according to category and technology. Information about this can be found in the Race Information for the event.

Competition 10 races with 8 races in valuation. All starters drove the same time distance on each lane according to the rating. Speed controllers and slot cars were provided to the racers.

Classification The classification was done by points awarded per race based on the vehicle position at the finish line. For vehicles that came out of the slot, participation in the race ended with the highest number of points scored (number of vehicles started plus 1 additional point). Points were added-up at the end. In the overall result, the participants drove for classification in competition ranking classes. For more information on the classification and the valid points scoring key, see Race Information.

Racing Service A general track cleaning was carried out the day before the event was held. The track was then broken in with autonomously driving chassis in order to bring all tracks to a uniform level of grip. The process was repeated on the day of the event before the start of training to make sure the track is also dust-free. To promote equal opportunities, a tire service was carried out on the drive wheels before each race. Before the races, a few drops of Voodoo 3.0 were placed on the control pad on the controller's circuit board.

VINTAGE GRAND PRIX DE MINIATURE At The Pits

In practice for race 6, the Hurricane motorcycle start no. 2 didn't drive as it should. When the obligatory replacement of the speed controller did not bring any improvement, a short technical check got the racing sidecar going again.

Towards the end of the first practice session for race 7, an engine failure (which was later repairable) made the fast drive of the Lotus with start no. 1 came to an abrupt end and took the vehicle out of the competition. This led to the first start of a replacement car. The spare Lotus starting no. 5 then shone in the race with the second fastest lap time of 5.418 seconds.


Race 8 saw the first pit stop as the Matra start no. 4 suddenly slowed down. The problem was caused by a small piece of metal that founds it way into the engine. The piece was quickly removed and the race continued on after a short interruption.





